ADDENDUM TO ATTORNEY FEE AGREEMENT

This is an addendum to the Attorney Fee Agreement by and between the Arvin Community Services District and Wall, Wall & Peake effective March 1, 2014.

The Attorney Fee Agreement shall be amended as follows:

- 1. Said Attorney Fee Agreement shall be extended through and including March 31, 2022, unless earlier terminated by either party.
- 2. There shall be a three percent (3%) increase per year in the current attorney hourly rate with said increase being effective on April 1, 2019, April 1, 2020 and April 1, 2021.
- 3. WW&P carries Errors and Omissions Coverage through Berkley Insurance Company in the amount of \$1,000,000 per claim, with an aggregate of \$2,000,000. The policy number is: PLP-1528887-P3.

The Arvin Community Services District understands it has the right to have separate legal counsel review this Addendum to the Attorney Fee Agreement.

All other terms and conditions of the previously amended Attorney Fee Agreement not modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.
